We accompany and stimulate children with handicap individually in **Kindergarten or school**.

The integration assistance for Kindergarten or school provides carefully selected carers, who focus on the integration of children with handicap and accompany them according to their individual needs. They work closely together with teachers and therapists in order to achieve an optimal support for the child.



Leisure time

Also in **leisure time** we offer support and assistance to children and juveniles with disability and help them to realise their individual wishes, goals and needs.

In addition we provide individual guardians, who visit children with handicap in the family and take care for them, while parents have appointments, etc. We also offer holiday activities for children and juveniles with handicap, several activity groups and day care during the holidays.

In **Occupational therapy**, children, juveniles and adults are assisted in their ability to act. Children learn by play. While playing they acquire new skills that help them to catch up with their development deficits.

In cooperation with the family ways will be developed to support the child in its daily life and to strengthen the family bounding.



Tomatis therapy is an intensive hearing training focussing on the treatment of learning disabilities, delayed development or attention disorders.

Through listening training the development of the auditory system will be activated. As a result, incorrect learning processes will be remedied, the way for a correct perception and processing is made.
